- Pedestrians.




One out of every five construction accidents involve scaffolding. OSHA created standards to regulate the use of:

- Base plates and mud sills;
- Scaffold ties;
- Side brackets;
- Guard railing;
- Toeboards;
- Work platform decking; and
- Fastening pins.

Most scaffoldings accidents can be avoided with proper care by assuring that all of the OSHA standards are followed.

The most common causes of scaffolding accidents are:



- Improper construction;
- Lack of safety features; and
- Negligence in failing to provide proper supervision and/or maintenance.
